### "What Bible do you protect?"

And so it continues: Rumor and misinformation will always be the rule and guide of people who refuse to research, or bother to ask the right people questions about our Fraternity. The question itself insinuates the possibility that we are a religion and would defend to the bitter end a particular "Bible".

When I was asked "What Bible do you protect?" and saw that the person asking it was quite serious, there were many thoughts and answers racing through my mind. Most of the answers my brain conjured would have shown my quick wit and sarcastic talents, but seeing how serious this person was, I settled on the answer that is so obvious to those of us who are Masons. We do not "protect" Bibles. Our Fraternity uses the Holy Writings as our guide to help us govern our lives in a just and upright manner, as we walk before God and man in our several stations in life.

We refer to religious scripture or text as 'Holy Writings' because we accept all good men into the Fraternity, regardless of their religious beliefs. The only religious requirement to become a Mason is that a man must believe in a Supreme Being. How then do we reconcile different religions within Lodge?

The answer is simple in its complexity. We, as Masons do not judge our brothers, nor do we promote religion. We do however; encourage our Brethren to attend the church of THEIR choice. We come together as Brother Masons as one craft, under one roof, with a diversity that would have made President John F. Kennedy and Dr. Martin Luther King proud.

The 'Holy Writings' are displayed upon our altar while Lodge is in session. A Brother of the Muslim faith may see the Koran on the altar; a Christian Brother the Holy Bible, a Buddhist Brother the Buddha-Dharma. But how do we choose which 'Holy Writings' to open and display? Since the Worshipful Master of the Lodge is the leader of his Lodge, it is usually the Holy Writings of his faith that is displayed openly, unless he orders differently.

The one common feature that unites all of us as Brethren, regardless of our faith, is the Square and Compasses resting upon the open Holy Writings. The Square and Compasses remind us our faith, position, and standing in life, no matter who we are. That we, as Masons, are to square our actions with all people and keep our behavior circumscribed within due bounds of expected Masonic character, which is based upon the teachings of the 'Holy Writings'.


